This includes managing our coffee and food offerings, maintaining high standards of quality and customer service, and leading a team of volunteer baristas and café staff. Your role will be critical in creating a welcoming atmosphere for our customers, all while ensuring smooth operations and efficiency during the daytime hours.

Key Responsibilities:
